International co-operation in science is the key to excellent research, innovative ideas and important new findings. It is our aim to expand and consolidate cooperation between the DRESDEN-concept partners, the Prague universities and several research institutions during the exhibition period. In 2016, this



extensive Science Exhibition presented the DRESDEN-concept research priorities in the most prominent square in Dresden – the Neumarkt square – right in front of the Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady). The exhibition made research, conducted in the city, tangible to its residents and guests. It provided information regarding the research opportunities within the alliance as well as in Dresden. Cutting-edge results were displayed from the areas of biomedicine & bioengineering, information technology & microelectronics, materials & structures and culture & knowledge. Since May 2017, the exhibition has been on an international tour.

The first stop was King's College London, where Dresden and London-based scientists held joint networking events, key note lectures and panel discussions with the common goal of contributing to the international research exchange and of developing synergies in science. It then moved to Plac Solny, the Salt Market, in Wrocław. Five Polish universities joined the DRESDEN-concept science alliance in furthering the networking among neighbours across national borders.

The next and last stop of the science exhibition will be **Prague from 10 April until 5 May 2018. Dresden- and Prague-based scientists will once again be given the opportunity to exchange ideas during scientific lectures and to develop and consolidate the partnership between the two scientific locations.**
