

## Call for POVIM fund – SS 2022/2023



### Information:

- The POVIM fund is intended for CU academic staff who teach a course open to virtual mobility (VM), and administrative staff who take care of the administration and management of VM at CU as part of their agenda.
- Financial support is a one-time benefit to be received with a salary.
- Within the open selection procedure, the faculty submits a single application for all its applicants via the electronic records management system (ESS). The addressee is the head of IRO CU.
- Only courses open in the winter semester may receive funding.
- 4EU+ Shared Courses and Open courses (category 2 and 3) can apply. For an Open Course applying for POVIM, the syllabus in SIS has to be completed by 10<sup>th</sup> December.
- The categories and the amount of support are:
  - 15.000 CZK for academics who creates a new course open for virtual mobility,
  - 7.500 CZK for academics who maintain a previously taught course open for virtual mobility and they open it repeatedly,
  - 7.500 CZK for administrative staff managing virtual mobility.

### Process:

The faculty ensures the distribution of the information and arranges an internal selection procedure. Approved applications are to be submitted by the faculty in a single application for all its applicants via the electronic records management system (ESS), the addressee is the head of IRO CU. **The deadline is 10<sup>th</sup> December.**

The results will be announced after the central selection at the beginning of January. The money will be transferred to faculties in February (after a notice that all selected courses are taught).
