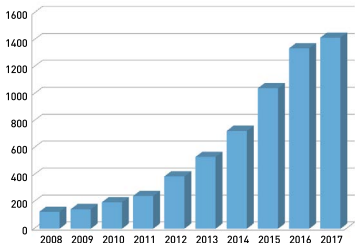

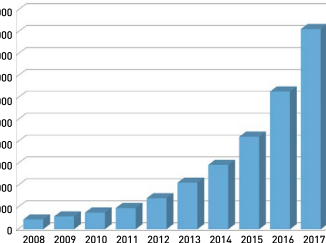

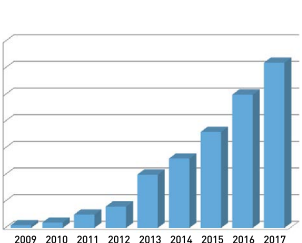
Number of Academic Publications per Year
