

## Call for nominations (as at: January 2025)

### Exchange scholarship for students from HHU partner universities

<b>Who is eligible?</b>	Students studying at a university outside Germany with which a Cooperation Agreement exists or is to be concluded. The partner university may nominate one candidate per selection round.
<b>What is the objective of the scholarship?</b>	To strengthen international partnerships in all faculties through the exchange of students.
<b>Which conditions must be fulfilled?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The nominees from the partner university have a non-German university entrance qualification.</li> <li>• Confirmation of academic supervision from an HHU lecturer is available.</li> </ul>
<b>Scope and duration of funding</b>	Funding of up to €984 per month can be provided for up to 5 months (no extension possible). (Living costs in Düsseldorf amount to around € 1.000 per month.)
<b>Who nominates candidates?</b>	The International Office of the respective partner university selects a suitable candidate and nominates them <b>online</b> : <a href="#">Nomination form for the winter semester 2025/26</a> .
<b>Who <u>cannot</u> be nominated?</b>	Students with a non-German university entrance qualification who receive funding via Erasmus or from an other scholarship organisation at the same time.
<b>Deadline for nominations</b>	<b>10 March</b> for the next winter semester <b>20 October</b> for the next summer semester.
<b>Application deadline at the home university</b>	Defined by the home university.
<b>Application documents</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Written confirmation from an HHU lecturer that they are willing to provide the usual level of academic supervision for the student</li> <li>2. Certificate of enrolment from the partner university</li> <li>3. Proof of German and/or English language proficiency (B1 level in each case)</li> </ol>
<b>Who makes the selection?</b>	A selection committee coordinated by the International Office.
<b>What are the selection criteria?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A complete application has been submitted on time.</li> <li>• In the event that the number of applications received exceeds the amount of funding available, priority will be given to partner universities which have not received funding in the past or which have not received funding for a longer period.</li> </ul>
