On Thursday, 27 March 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. an exchange of research topics related to the implementation of joint MSc and PhD theses between the Universities and the European research infrastructure ELI ERIC will take place as a hybrid meeting in Room 241/A-1 (Wrocław University of Science and Technology, Senate Hall).

The event will include the presentation of approximately 30 Master's/Doctoral thesis proposals and will be streamed online (link to be shared).

The topics will be presented by scientists from the two ELI ERIC facilities, ELI Beamlines in Dolní Břežany (Czechia) and ELI – ALPS in Szeged (Hungary).

The Master's/Doctoral theses will be realized in a collaboration between the University and ELI ERIC under the supervision of a university employee and the expert supervision of an ELI ERIC facility employee.
